

Are you looking for a venue to host a Christmas party?

Then look no further, as The Malthouse Project could be your answer.

The Malthouse Project is a 17th Century Grade II listed building, which offers charming surroundings for the festive period.

The former maltings has three function rooms available to hire, which can accommodate between six and 50 people. Each room offers its own unique atmosphere: the Beamed Room is the largest, with oak beams lining the ceiling and an original 1600s barn wall; the Heritage Room contains a miniature museum of malting artefacts dating back hundreds of years; and the Kiln Café, ideal for evening and weekend functions, provides a light and spacious room. Room hire rate is applicable for evening bookings.



In addition to room hire, The Malthouse Project also provides an in-house catering service. All the food is freshly prepared in the Project's Kiln Café. The mouth-watering 2008 Christmas menu ranges from a main course at £7.00 per person to a choice of four courses at £13.50 per person, providing flexibility to meet everyone's dining preferences and budgets.

The Malthouse Project is owned by St Matthew Housing (SMH), part of Genesis Housing Group. SMH is a charity providing accommodation and support to people who are homeless or unsuitably housed. The Project provides SMH residents and service users the opportunity to gain work experience and training qualifications in the café. All income generated from the room hire and Christmas catering funds the social objectives of the project.
